Frequently Asked Questions

What is required to turn on the camera?

The responsible party or self requires consent.

What if there is a double occupancy?

Both residents need to consent to enable the service.

Where is the camera placed?

The cameras are installed on the ceiling corner of the resident's bedroom without a field of view into the bathroom.

Is it always recording-even with visitors?

The service is always running but only video related to the detected event is retained for review by the community.

Can anyone watch the resident at any time?

No, the service is running and processed securely by the SafelyYou server, and live streaming is unavailable for staff.
